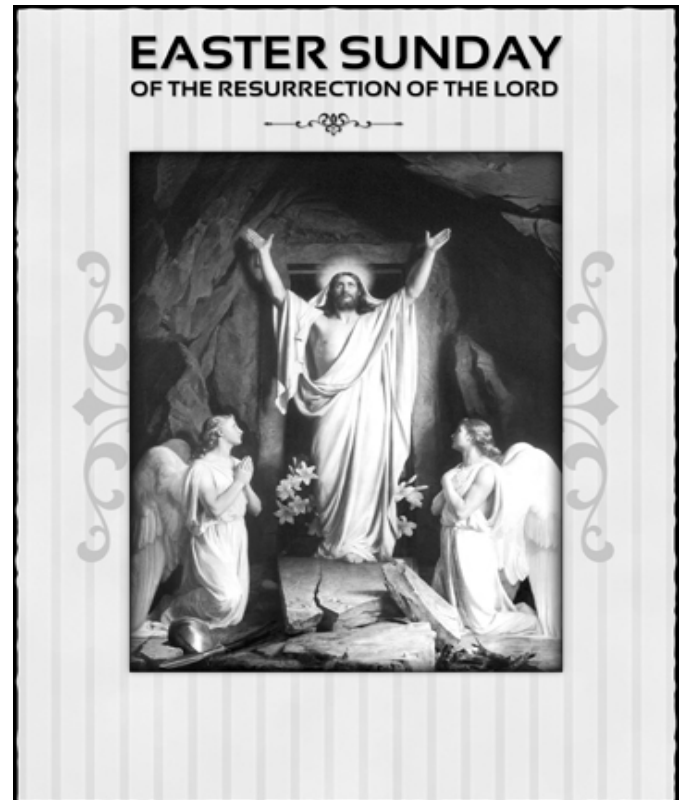
## **Matrimony**
